PROGRAMS

The Zeiterion Main Stage Series:

With a goal of becoming a major cultural force in the region and at the same time serving our community, our performance series features between 35 and 40 world class performances each year including jazz, world music, dance, musicals, theatre, comedy, blues, pop music, and family programs.

The School-Time Performance Program

annually offers more than 35 quality curriculum-based performances to 25,000 schoolchildren in grades pre-K-12 and serves schools throughout southeastern Massachusetts. Our School-Time Performances are offered during the school day.

Kennedy Center "Partners in Education" program: The Z and the New Bedford Public Schools' have partnered together with the Kennedy Center's program "Partners in Education" to develop a teacher professional development program for educator's throughout the region that provides skills and tools to integrate the arts and arts-based learning into the curriculum.

The Zeiterion Book Club: New this season, the Z's *From Page to Stage* book club will read and discuss 4 books whose themes will come alive at performances presented throughout our season. Club members will examine and experience rich and diverse subject matter in a 4-part series of captivating discussions. It's free, open to all, and participants enjoy discounts to linked performances. Visit our website, www.zeiterion.org for more information.

Arts Access: 8,000 free tickets are provided to low income families to performances. The Z works with the juvenile court system, Third Eye, Youthbuild, and the New Bedford school system among others.

Community Programs:

The Z has initiated ArtsBridge, a new strategy to strengthen its educational and community programs. ArtsBridge brings together, in a cohesive whole, the Z's three main programming thrusts – community projects, performance, and educational programs, creating a synergy with which the Zeiterion and the arts can galvanize and build relationships with the community in common purpose.

Revitalization of Downtown: The Z is a major economic driver of downtown revitalization, with a 1.8 million dollar and 89 job direct impact on the local economy. The Z has developed joint marketing partnerships with local businesses and organizations. It is a recipient of state tourism funds which are used to market the Z and the city throughout the region. Each year from New England and beyond, 100,000 people pass through our doors.
